Facts about Worms:

- Worms are also known as Earthworms because they burrow in the soil.
- Worms eat almost anything that was alive, as long as it is dead when they eat it.
- When a worm expels its waste it is called 'castings'. These castings make new soil rich in nutrients.
- Worms use their skin to breathe and do not have lungs.
- Worms release a fluid onto their skin which helps them move through underground burrows easier.
- Worms hatch from eggs, tiny but fully formed.
- Worms have 5 hearts.
- Worms have the ability to eat their own weight in a day.
- If a worm becomes dehydrated and its skin dries out it will die.
