



Aboard a rocky pirate ship In the middle of the sea Are a funny group of pirates Who are as useless as can be!






There's Pirate Jim Who cannot swim, Pirate Dave Who's scared of waves,


Pirate Nick Who gets sea-sick, Pirate Dale Who cannot sail,

Falling Leaves


Little leaves fall softly down Red and yellow, orange and brown

s is for slide and slip and for snow t is for tide and trip and for toe







u is for under and up and for use v is for van, vet, vex, vow and views












My Senses on hear the birds sing,
