Can you find out some exciting facts about the people who live in this country?

- What nationality are they?
- What languages do they speak?
- Can you find out something about the culture?
- How do they dress? Do they look the same as us or different?
- What types of homes and buildings do they have?



Animals

Can you find out which animals live in this country? What fun facts can you find out? Some ideas might include;

- make a fact file and write about what facts you have found out?
- create a picture or a model of your favourite animal or the habitat that they live in.
- make a chart to compare the animals in this country and England.



Talking Together

Can you talk to your grownups about what you have learnt about your chosen country?

Think about;



- Why I choose this country?
- What do I like the best about this country?
- What facts have I learnt?
- What is my favourite fact and why?
- How is it similar to where I live?

Other Ideas

Can you draw / create the national flag from your chosen Country?

What types of foods do they eat in this country?
Can you make up your own recipe?

What types of musical instruments do they play?
What songs do they sing?

Can you make your own musical instrument or find out and sing some traditional songs?
