We will be reading the book

The Colour Monster by Anna Llenas

One day, Colour Monster wakes up feeling very confused. His emotions are all over the place; he feels angry, happy, calm, sad and scared all at once! To help him, a little girl shows him what each feeling means through colour.

We will be exploring colour through mixed media.

We will be practising hearing the initial sounds of words starting with s and a. We will be playing Silly Soup. The Silly Soup Song (to tune of Pop goes the Weasel) "I'm making lots of silly soup, I'm making soup that's silly. I'm going to cook it in the fridge, To make it nice and chilly."



Each child will take a turn to stir the soup while everyone joins in singing the song. We may add things starting with s — snake, socks, spiderman or words that the adult orally blend c-a-t or d-o-q or rhyming words — cat, bat, mat.

We will be talking about our emotions, discussing times when we have felt happy, sad, worried, angry. We will be thinking about things that we can do to help one another when we're feeling sad, worried or angry.
