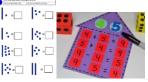

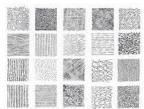


#### COMPUTING

MARK MAKING IDEAS

#### Core strength & crossing the midline

We are focusing on our core strength and crossing the midline to help our motor skills and handwriting. You can practise this at home:

#### Rub a dubs

Gently rub your hand in a circle on your stomach. Stop, then pat your head with the other hand gently, Now do both at the same time and at a similar pace.

You should be rubbing your stomach whilst patting your head. Try to maintain the difference in each movement. Swap around. Pat your stomach whilst rubbing your head.
