Parent

To support my child at school, I know and understand that:

- I should check my child for symptoms of illness each morning.
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19. I will follow the procedure for testing and self-isolation until any test results are received. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone:
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately:
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the appropriate drop off /collection points:
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly adhere to the school timings:
- If necessary, my child will only bring a lunchbox with a drink to school
- My child will only bring a book bag and a P.E bag to school - other items only on request
- I will remind my child to implement good respiratory and hand hygiene, following appropriate guidance;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create the safest possible environment for all pupils:
- If necessary, I will remind my child about social distancing but accept that young children may find them difficult to follow and that my child and other children may not always do this successfully without reminders
- I need to read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home:
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to emergency contact details for my child.
- If my child's behaviour is deemed unsafe he/she may be sent home and may not return until they can behave safely.

Pupil

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to any necessary Covid guidance in class and on the playground:
- Move around school as instructed:
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell:
- Only bring a lunchbox and drink for lunchtime into school:
- Only mix or play with children I am instructed to in the event of an outbreak
- Only enter and exit the school building via the designated routes and follow the routines that have been set up:
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it) and avoid touching my mouth, nose and hands:
- Follow good hand hygiene use soap and water for 20 seconds or hand sanitiser:
- Only enter the toilet if there is no one else in there
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others:
- Not cough, or spit, at or towards others;
- Follow all these expectations and know that if I don't, I may be sent home and may not be able to come back into school until I can do SO.
