If you see anything you do not like, turn over the device, or turn it off and speak to a grown up.</p> <p>You could then find some information about your animal, using these questions:</p> <p>What does it look like?</p> <p>What does it eat?</p> <p>Where does it live?</p> <p>Can you also find an interesting fact about your animal?</p> <p>You could also use the paint program on Purple mash to create a picture of your animal.</p> <p>Enjoy your research.</p>
