Helping with Phonics

We are concentrating on recapping all the sounds and tricky words from P2 to P5.

We follow the same format everyday

For example:

We start with days of the week

Day one - Monday, January, one

Day two – Tuesday, February, two.....and so on.

(These are words the children are expected to spell in KS1)

We will then recap some sounds or tricky words (words that can't be blended)

We use online resources to play games and activities to support this learning.
