We will be 'subitising' and sharpening the children's noticing skills.

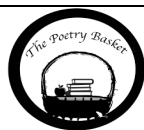
We will be looking at everyday objects and talking about what we notice about them, putting them into groups and learning about 1,2,3 and sharing our learning from last week.

And have a drink with me.



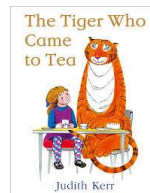
We will also be starting our Christmas Poems!
