The school will endeavour to:

- Provide a safe environment by risk assessing in response to the COVID-19 infection and putting in place protective measures for the benefit of all stakeholders;
- Adhere to the social distancing guidance as set out by Government in as far as is reasonably practicable;
- Provide a curriculum for school and home learning that supports the needs of pupils and includes development of their well-being, mental health as well as academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers immediately if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if a staff member or a pupil in your child's 'bubble' has a confirmed case of COVID-19. This will mean your household will need to self-isolate for at least 10 days or until a COVID-19 test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to behaviour management, through rewards and sanctions, as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, email and the school website.

To support my child's return to school, I know and understand that:

- I should check my child for symptoms of illness each morning including checking their temperature.
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will get tested and self-isolate as a family until any test results are received. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly adhere to the school timings for my child;
- My child will only bring a lunchbox, drink for lunch time and a snack box (if required) to school
- My child will not bring any other items into school with them (including a bag) or take items home from school;
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules but accept that young children may find them difficult to follow and that my child and other children may not always do this successfully without reminders
- I will remind my child to implement good respiratory and hand hygiene, following appropriate guidance;
- I will not attempt to enter the school building unless called in – please contact via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create the safest possible environment during this crisis;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to emergency contact details for my child.
- If my child's behaviour is deemed unsafe in these unprecedented times, he/she may be sent home and may not return until they can behave safely.

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Move around school as instructed trying to maintain social distance;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Only bring a lunchbox, drink for lunchtime and snack into school;
- Use only the equipment given to me and not share my equipment with others;
- Only mix or play with children from my allocated group
- Only enter and exit the school building via the designated route and follow the routines that have been set up;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it) and avoid touching my mouth, nose and hands;
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds or hand sanitiser;
- Only enter the toilet if there is no one else in there
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Not cough, or spit, at or towards others;
- Follow all these expectations and know that if I don't, I may be sent home and may not be able to come back into school until I can do so.
