Recounts

When writing a recount we try to include:

- Time connectives – First, Then, Next, After that, Soon after that, A while later, Eventually, Finally, days of the week
- A scene setting opening
- An ending with comments on events
- Engaging details to bring events alive

Recounts

- Onomatopoeia words, for example ZOOM! MUNCH!
- Adjectives, for example the crunchy carrots or the dazzling, white swans
- Two adjectives, for example the scary old woman
- Adjectives: list of three for description
– he wore old shoes a dark cloak and a red hat

Recounts

- Alliteration, for example Percy Pig
- Simile – it was as fun as a party or his eyes were as big as saucers
- Adverbs – slowly, quickly
- Repetition in description – a lean cat, a mean cat or following a pattern – days of the week

Recounts

- 'ly' openers (finally, luckily, fortunately, unfortunately)
- New vocabulary from reading experiences
- Simple conjunctions: and, or, but, so, because, that, then, that, while, when, where
- Openers: While... When... Where...


Recounts

Particularly for Year 2

- Engaging details to bring events alive
- Write as if 'telling a story' of what happened
- Specific names of people, places, events and objects
- Personal response to what was seen
- Additional information given to the reader using brackets

Heidi the hen went for a walk.


First she went across the dusty yard.

On Monday I ate some crunchy carrots. CRUNCH CRUNCH!


On Tuesday I ate some tasty tomatoes. Mmm!

First I played in the garden. I played hide and seek with my gran and I won!


Then we had some lunch. I had chicken cheese and chorizo sandwiches.

Recount - Year 1




Last week I flew to the moon in a rocket. ZOOM!

It was the best day of my life.




Recount - Year 1


At Porchester castle museum.

- create your very own original recount.


Real Life Recount Ideas...

- Go for a walk and write about it. You may wish to take some photographs so that you have visual prompts





- Read Kipper's Diary - free on Oxford Owl

- Watch a clip from You Tube feeding at the zoo, going on a safari, penguins in the Antarctic and recount your imaginary trip there.




- Share a story, choose a character and recount their actions and adventures.

- Watch Magic Grandad on You Tube.




Recount a trip back in time.
