Inside a religious building

During the summer term we have a look at special religious buildings and what is inside them. We talk about which buildings are special to different religions and why. We look at certain artefacts such as holy books and symbols and discuss what they mean. We usually take a lovely trip to the local church and spend the morning with the vicar, making drawings, learning about the church and doing a treasure hunt.

As we are unable to do this at the moment your child might like to find out a little bit about a religious building; a Church, a Synagogue or a Mosque.

They could draw and label a picture of it.

Find out 5 or more amazing facts!

Draw and label one or two important items such as a Bible for The Christian faith, a Menorah for The Jewish faith or prayer mats for The Muslim faith. You could look at one religion or all three!

Write a sentence or two about what the items/artefacts are used for and why.

Your child could make a poster or a booklet or just draw a picture.
