<p>This week's story is Cinderella</p>  <p>We will be developing our communication and language skills with special words throughout the week. Our value is kindness and we will consider how we demonstrate these values in our learning environment.</p>	 <p>Our poem this week is called:</p> <p>Furry Furry Squirrel</p> <p>Furry, furry squirrel, Hurry, hurry, hop. Scurry up the tree trunk, To the very top.</p> <p>When you reach the branches, Hurry, turn around. Furry, furry squirrel, Scurry to the ground.</p>	<p>'What do you see and how do you see it?' This week we will also focus on subitising 5.</p> <p>We will also be counting forwards, backwards and re-ordering numbers along the number line, focussing on the numbers 0-10 and matching numerals to quantities.</p> 
<p>Our number rhyme this week is 5 Fat Sausages Sizzling in a Pan. We will also be singing along to the song 'Hickory Dickory Dock'</p>  	<p>We will be continuing to practise hearing the initial sounds of words starting with <i>s, a, t, p, i, n, d</i>. We will be focusing in on our listening skills with lots of oral blending. We will use sound buttons and our magic fingers to segment and blend those sounds to hear and say words such as s-a-t, p-a-t, t-a-p. We will be playing phonics games to practise our sounds.</p> <p>We will be blending and reading the High Frequency words <i>is, it, in, an, dad</i>.</p> <p>We will be learning the tricky word <i>the</i>.</p>  	<p>There will be lots of writing opportunities this weeks along the theme of Cinderella.
